

Covid 19 Plan for OK Charge One Day Tournaments 2021

as of 1/10/21 at 2:00pm

(All Covid 19 plans can change in an instant, depending on the state of Covid 19 in Oklahoma, Oklahoma City and the OAC, we'll update you with changes ASAP)

Process for entering and exiting the building for staff, attendees, teams and officials.

- Only Essential Spectators please. We encourage you to facebook live your match for those who should stay home! The Balcony will be open for videoing!
- Players/Coaches will be let into the building at 7:15am
- Spectators will be let into the building at 7:30am. Please stay socially distanced while paying gate.
- Everyone will move through one entrance/exit without congregating please!

Court Limits:

- Only the two competing teams and the officiating team may be around the court at one time (A vs B, their spectators w/ C officiating with {no C spectators}).
- All other spectators and the "off" team must go to the empty court(s) or outside to space out, camp out and wait for their next match.
- Teams will stay on their side of the court the entire match
- Spectators will space out as much as possible

Mask Rules:

- Per the City of Oklahoma City and with precedence set by OSSAA, CDC approved Masks must be worn by all, including players in the bench area.
- Only Officials, once on the stand (R1) and once play begins (R2), players on the court and coaches whose team is currently playing may be unmasked.
- Players on the bench must be masked.
- The Officiating team must be masked with no food at the score table.
- Children will follow the Oklahoma City mask mandate at the time of the tournament (currently under the age of 10 does not have to be masked)
- If you have a medical condition prohibiting a CDC appropriate mask, **a face shield will be required.**

Bench Rules:

Sanitation:

- Balls & scorekeeping writing utensils will be cleaned between matches (officiating team will pick up a new ball, pens and pencils when they pick up scoring paperwork and bring it all back at the end of their officiated match)
- Hand sanitizing and hand washing will be strongly encouraged
- All trash and debris will be picked up by the competing teams before leaving their bench every match.

Ways you can help the most:

- Only be at your court when it is time for your individual team to play and leave immediately when done.
- Stay 6 feet apart when possible
- Stay masked up and enforce keeping masks on for your team and your spectators!
- Wash your hands often!
- Stay home if even slightly sick... allergy symptoms are covid symptoms too!
- Honor and do what you are being asked to do so our teams can all play and continue to play!**
